



Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)

WIOA was signed into law on July 22, 2014 and is designed to help job seekers access employment, education, training, and support services to succeed in the labor market and to match employers with the skilled workers they need to compete in the global economy.



Three Pillars of WIOA

- 1. The demands of business and workers drive workforce solutions.
- 2. The workforce system supports strong regional economies.
- 3. Career Centers provide first-rate customer service to jobseekers.



Goals of WIOA

- > Increase access
- Create a high-quality workforce
- Improve workforce investment efforts
- Promote improvements in structure
- Increase prosperity
- Reduce welfare dependency
