Comments: Overall I recommend the Discovery Education Social Studies Techbook for US History Adv. & CP.

The strengths are the amount of information the materials contain and the plethora of digital resources that are included. The Techbook is visually stimulating and relatively easy to navigate. There are lots of resources and strategies for the teacher including lessons, teacher preparation, and class management tools. The 5Es approach would make it effective and adaptable in the classroom. The lessons and activities are engaging and effective. In addition, there is access to the Discovery website / app. There are great features for the 21st century classroom on the home page including activities, videos, and social media for engaging students in current events.

The weaknesses would be the materials reliance on technology and the internet as well as the reliance on Discovery Education as the provider / creator of many of the resources including videos, maps and some secondary sources. Both teachers and students would have to be good with technology to effectively use these materials.

Each page has interactive features such as videos, images, maps, investigations, virtual tours, graphic organizers, etc. The lesson overview and teacher preparation features have access to many activities and resources that would also motivate the students. Discovery Education also has the MyDE component that has many features and connections to current events both local and global.

B. Teaching a Few "Big Ideas" 2. B. Instructional materials thoroughly teach a few important ideas, concepts, or themes.
