  - Note taking tools are available for students to write ideas online; as they are processing curriculum content.
    - A student Notebook is available as part of the online program. It is found at the top of each screen above the navigation bar. Students can write and save notes while reading the content by toggling between screens. Additionally, each lesson includes an online, writable graphic organizers and Note Taking activity with writable, savable PDF worksheets.
4. Which of the following **assistive technology supports, by product name**, have you tested for use with the instructional materials:
- Assistive technology software that can be run in the background. Examples include:
    1. Magnification
      - To magnify a screen page, students can hold down the CTRL + keys. To return to the standard screen size, hold down the CTRL – keys.
    2. Text-to-speech
      - Students with a visual impairment or reading disability may listen to an audio recording of the lesson by selecting the “headphones” button.
    3. Text-to-American Sign Language
