EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

On July 15, 2020, revisions to the B.E.S.T. Standards for ELA and Mathematics were adopted by the State Board of Education. With the adoption of revised standards, course descriptions need to be updated to include the most current standards. The proposed rule amendment will adopt English Language Arts, Mathematics and non-ELA and non-Mathematics subject area course descriptions that include the B.E.S.T. Standards for English Language Arts and Mathematics.

In total, there are 936 courses impacted by this rule amendment.

- 57 revised English Language Arts
- 28 Mathematics (24 revised and 4 new)
- 851 non-ELA and non-mathematics subject area courses.
