EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Postsecondary institutions apply to the Council for approval to participate in the State Authorization Reciprocity Agreement (SARA). Florida is a state member of the National Council – SARA, which allows institutions to provide distance education services to students in other states without requiring individual licensure in each individual state. The proposed new rule outlines the procedure for institutions appealing Council denials for initial participation or renewal of participation in FL-SARA. This rule is required as part of Florida's participation in the National Council – SARA.
