EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Section 1002.3305, Florida Statutes, requires the State Board of Education to contract with the operator of a college-preparatory boarding academy selected through a competitive request for proposals.

The Department of Education selected the SEED School of Miami, Inc. to operate the academy and entered into a contract in May 2014. The authorizing statute provides that the academy is created for the purpose of providing unique educational opportunities to dependent or at-risk children who are academic underperformers but who have the potential to progress from at-risk to college-bound.

The purpose of this amendment is to reduce the Contracted Appropriations for Year 8 based on the approved annual State Appropriation of \$9,189,478.00, which is 20% less than anticipated appropriations as outlined in Revised Exhibit 1: Payments and Deliverables Schedule approved in Contract Amendment 4. Year 8 appropriations equates to serving a maximum of 320 students at a quarterly rate of \$7,179.28 per student. In an effort to service as many students as possible while not reducing the Deliverables and services outline in Table 2 for the applicable budget year, SEED School of Miami will modified the number of students served for the FY 2021-22 School Year.
