Section 1003.631, Florida Statutes, requires the State Board of Education to designate a school as a School of Excellence. Pursuant to FDOE Emergency Order No. 2021-EO-02, only schools for which an approved opt-in request was submitted by the school district superintendent or charter school governing board have a letter grade assigned for the 2020-21 school year. School of Excellence designations for schools with an approved opt-in request in 2020-21 reflect the school's eligibility taking 2020-21 performance into account. Schools that did not opt in to receive a 2020-21 school grade remained unchanged in 2020-21, and 2020-21 performance data are not used in determining the designations for 2021-22.
