**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The purpose of this new rule is to ensure compliance with the Florida Department of Education's (FDOE) Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) State Plan specific to education for homeless children and youth, and address recommendations identified in the Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability (OPPAGA) Homeless and Foster Youth Services Report (December 2022).

The proposed rule will establish state standards for identifying students experiencing homelessness and training relevant school and district staff on the implementation of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act and other pertinent topics relating to students experiencing homelessness.
