The State Board of Education will consider whether the Broward County School Board is unwilling or unable to comply with section 1002.33(17), F.S., regarding revenue it collected under a local ad valorem tax. On March 27, 2024, the State Board of Education found that the Broward County School Board was not complying with section 1002.33(17), F.S., and ordered it to come into compliance by April 16, 2024. The State Board will now determine whether the District is unwilling or unable to comply and, if so, what actions should be taken to bring the Board into compliance.
