Please see the scheduling guidance below for each computer-based test (CBT).

RETAKES

The administration window for Spring Retakes is **April 8 – 19, 2013.** CBT sessions may be scheduled during the entire Retake window.

- FCAT Mathematics Retake: Students may have up to the length of a typical school day to complete the test but must complete the test in one day.
- FCAT 2.0 Reading Retake: The FCAT 2.0 Reading Retake is administered in two sessions over two days. Students may have up to half the length of a typical school day to complete each session.

FCAT 2.0 ASSESSMENTS

Grades 6, 7, 9, and 10 FCAT 2.0 Reading and Grade 5 FCAT 2.0 Mathematics will be administered in two 70-minute sessions over two days.

Week 1 (April 15 – 19)

- Grade 10: Schools may begin administering Grade 10 FCAT 2.0 Reading on Day 1 and may administer make-up tests through April 24.
- **Grade 7**: Schools may begin administering Grade 7 FCAT 2.0 Reading on **Day 2** and may administer make-up tests through April 24.

Week 2 (April 22 – 26)

- **Grade 5**: Schools may begin administering Grade 5 FCAT 2.0 Mathematics on **Day 6** and may administer make-up tests through April 30.
- **Grades 6 and 9**: Schools may begin administering Grades 6 and 9 FCAT 2.0 Reading on **Day 6** and may administer make-up tests through April 30.

Paper-based accommodations (regular print, large print, and braille) for CBT administrations will be provided for eligible students, as indicated on student IEPs or Section 504 plans. Paper-based accommodations should be administered according to the Daily Session Schedule on the previous page.

No deviation from the established FCAT/FCAT 2.0 administration schedule is allowed without written approval from the FDOE prior to implementation.
