**SUBJECT:** Approval of Amendment to Rule 6A-10.0401, Gold Standard Career Pathways Articulation Agreements

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

This rule incorporates statewide articulation agreements that guarantee the award of a specified number of college credits to students who have earned the specified industry certification and are enrolled in the designated Associate of Science degree or Associate of Applied Science degree program at Florida College System institutions. Since 2008, 116 Gold Standard Career Pathway Articulation Agreements have been approved by the State Board of Education in six phases. Approval of this rule will add the following six new agreements to the document Gold Standard Career Pathways Articulation Agreements of Industry Certification to AAS/AS Degree 2013-2014 Academic Year:

1. Certified Apprentice Drafter-Architectural to Architectural Design and Construction
2. FAA Powerplant Mechanic to Aviation Maintenance Management
3. Agriculture Technician Certification to Agriculture Production Technology
4. Microsoft Technology Associate (MTA) – HTML5 Application Development Fundamentals to Internet Services Technology
5. National Pharmacy Technician Certification to Pharmacy Management
6. Oracle Certified Associate (OCA) – Java Programmer to Computer Programming and Analysis
