

# Organizations Approved to Provide PEC Programs



Pursuant to section 1012.56, Florida Statutes, demonstrated professional education competence is a requirement for professional educator certification. This requirement is satisfied through graduation from an approved educator preparation program; through a public school district program; or, for teachers at private or charter schools, through an organization that provides these services as part of its master inservice plan (MIP). Arrangements to deliver the program are made between private or charter schools and the organizations, and the sponsoring organization reports participation information to the state.
