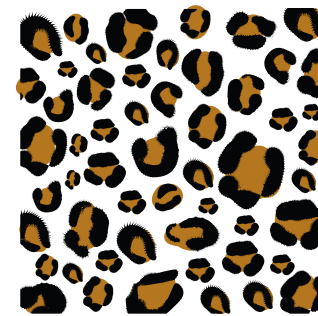

Literacy Week 2021



Activities will run throughout the week:

- Writing Contest announced through Canvas will begin on Monday, January 25th and end of February 5th. The writing will be based on the Theme: "Humanity Tells A Story: What's Your Chapter?"- Prizes will be awarded to winners.
- Daily Morning Show (Monday through Friday) announcements available in Canvas will include a reading from SLAM books and Bluford Series. Students will have the chance to guess what book is being read from- A list will be provided to choose. Students will submit their answers electronically so both e-learners and brick and mortar students can participate. -Prize to be awarded from a randomly selected correct answer
- Teachers will be recorded reading from their favorite book. Students will guess who is reading based on voice recording. A list of teachers to pick from will be provided. Students will send their answers electronically so both e-learners and brick and mortar students can take part. - Prize to be awarded from a randomly selected correct answer
- Jars will be shown in Canvas from different angles showing a popular book. Students can electronically submit, through Canvas, their guess for a prize- Prize to be awarded from a randomly selected correct answer
- MyOn contest will run the week of January 25th -29th. The top students participating- based on the number of minutes reading for that week will win prizes.
- Signed book giveaways throughout the week through Library Services. The flyer will be posted in Canvas. Students will use Instagram page to be entered to win. Books will be sent to school to be given to students.

Monday 1/25/21 thru Friday 1/29/21 is **Literacy Week!** Here's how we'll be celebrating:

- **Monday Montage:** On **Monday the 25th**, Dr. Ponds and the morning show crew will kick off the week by featuring a montage highlighting favorite books of the morning show crew! Additionally, I will provide homeroom teachers with bookmarks to pass out to each of their students.
- **Tuesday Tastings:** On **Tuesday the 26th**, each teacher is asked to choose a book that's of high interest to students (*school and age appropriate, please*). As a bell work exercise (2-3 min), engage in a read aloud for 2-5 minutes during each class period. Finishing the book is not the goal. Just pique the students' interest – give 'em a taste! Feel free to continue with your read aloud after Tuesday! If you need help choosing a good book, Mrs. Bhoolai and I are happy to assist.
- **Wild Out Wednesday:** On **Wednesday the 27th**, both teachers and students who are '*wild about reading*' are asked to wear camouflage or an animal print of some sort (*students should still be in khaki bottoms*).
- **Thursday Thoughts:** On **Thursday the 28th**, as a bell work exercise (2-3 min), teachers are asked to share your favorite inspirational quote, proverb, line of poetry, passage from a book, etc. (*school and age appropriate, please*) and discuss it's meaning with your students. (For example, one of my favorites: "*Our deepest fear is not that we are inadequate. Our deepest fear is that we are powerful beyond measure!*" ~*Marianne Williamson*~ Share, then discuss.)
- **Fab Friday:** On **Friday the 29th**, both students and teachers are asked to wear t-shirts with fun, interesting, odd, artful, words / phrases / sentences (*school appropriate, please; students should still be in khaki bottoms*)!
