Reverse Transfer Articulation Agreement Guidance and Training

As a follow-up to our <u>previous correspondence</u> on statewide reverse transfer, please see the attached document, which provides guidance on the Statewide Reverse Transfer memorandum of understanding (MOU). We anticipate that the statewide reverse transfer process will begin the spring 2022 term. State University System institutions should be prepared to evaluate the transcripts of their current population of Florida College System transfer students by that time. Students should be contacted regarding their eligibility during the spring 2021 term.
