# 2023-24 CBO ADULT EDUCATION TEST & PERFORMANCE CHANGES: Division of Career & Adult Education

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#### **Overview of Changes**

- 1. Literacy completion points will be replaced with more appropriate programspecific data collection to more adequately collect information related to the expected outcomes for the students in the programs.
- 2. New data elements and data linkages to assessments must be established in the reporting structure for school districts, Florida College System institutions, corrections programs, and community-based providers with adult education programs.
- 3. Information to identify the adult test score used for the Initial and Final Educational Functioning Level (EFL) for each course should be reported by the agency. All adult tests delivered to a student should be reported and, if used for EFL assignments, be linked to the course record. These records will be used to determine the EFL for federal reporting at the state level.
- 4. For GED® preparation, information on GED® Tests Passed may be reported by agency to supplement records found with matching to the GED Testing database.
