#### INTRODUCTION

The 5-Year District Facilities Work Program is a very important document. The Department of Education, Legislature, Governor's Office, Division of Community Planning (growth management), local governments, and others use the work program information for various needs including funding, planning, and as the authoritative source for school facilities related information.

The district's facilities work program must be a complete, balanced capital outlay plan that is financially feasible. The first year of the work program is the districts capital outlay budget. To determine if the work program is balanced and financially feasible, the "Net Available Revenue" minus the "Funded Projects Costs" should sum to zero for "Remaining Funds".

If the "Remaining Funds" balance is zero, then the plan is both balanced and financially feasible.

If the "Remaining Funds" balance is negative, then the plan is neither balanced nor feasible.

If the "Remaining Funds" balance is greater than zero, the plan may be feasible, but it is not balanced.

# Planning

#### **Class Size Reduction Planning**

Plans approved by the school board that reduce the need for permanent student stations such as acceptable school capacity levels, redistricting, busing, year-round schools, charter schools, magnet schools, public-private partnerships, multitrack scheduling, grade level organization, block scheduling, or other alternatives.

A new technical high school (Kirkland Ranch Academy of Innovation) opened this year on the east side of the county. This school is drawing students from currently overcrowded high schools and will reduce the need for permanent student stations at these schools.

This school year, two elementary schools were converted to STEAM magnet schools. The attendance zones for these two schools were rezoned to other surrounding under-capacity elementary schools. The two magnet schools are being filled by application and will pull from other schools in those regions of the county.

There are several new charter schools planning to open in the next three years. This will reduce the need for permanent student stations in this area as students from both under-crowded and overcrowded traditional schools and other charter schools migrate to these new charter schools.

A new 6-12 magnet academy is scheduled to open in the central part of the county next school year. This school will provide additional student stations for anticipated growth and also draw students from overcrowded middle and high schools in the area.

A new K-8 magnet school is planned to open on the east side of the county in two years to accommodate continued growth in that area and reduce the need for traditional permanent seats in multiple other areas.

#### School Closure Planning

Plans for the closure of any school, including plans for disposition of the facility or usage of facility space, and anticipated revenues.

The school district is currently exploring various options with the City of New Port Richey to determine the future use of the Schwettman Education Center Campus.

The School Board recently voted to close Mittye P. Locke Elementary School to kindergarten through 5th grades. The school will remain open as an early childhood education center. The kindergarten through 5th grade students will be rezoned to neighboring schools that have available student capacity.

The school district is currently looking to dispose of the vacant Trilby Education Center and a couple of other vacant parcels. Any expected revenue from these sites will be reinvested into our educational programs.
