The CBO should report a "0" in the first field of the four character data element followed by the three digit score. For example, if a student receives a score of 485 on the Reading Level M Form 11 test, the CBO would report "0485" for the test score. (If the score had been OOR, then the score for the Reading Level M Form 11 score, for example, would be reported as "1442").

EDIT ERROR CODES Supplemental

The following codes are to be used with error codes listed on the <u>Supplemental Edit Error Report</u>. Edit errors occur when a value in a field is incorrect. Edits only look at a single format (Adult Demographic, Adult Course, Supplemental, or Adult Test Record), checking to make sure that each field contains valid data. <u>All edits are reject errors.</u>

- *S1 Survey Period Code must be 11, 1, 2, or 3 and must be correct for the submission period.
- *S2 **Postsecondary Course Status** must be equal to S, U, I, C, W, or Z.
- *S3 Industry Certification Outcome must be equal to P or F. If not applicable submit Z.
- *S4 Industry Certification Identifier must be valid or if not applicable all zeroes (00000000).
 - Note: See Appendix G for a list of valid Industry Certification Identifiers
- *S5 If Industry Certification Outcome is equal to "P", the Industry Certification Date Earned must be a valid MMDDYYYY date that is not in the future. For all other Industry Certification Outcomes, the Industry Certification Date Earned must be blank.
- *S6 Course Number must be a valid postsecondary CTE Course Number on Appendix G or if not applicable submit all zeroes (0000000).

 Note: For more information on Course Numbers refer to Appendix G in the CBO Database Handbook.
- *S7 Section Number must not be all zeroes, if valid Course Number is submitted

VALIDATION ERRORS

The following validation codes are to be used with the Adult Validation Error Report. Validations differ from edit errors as edits check individual records in a single format for required data, and validations check data across formats. For example, a standard Validation check makes sure that every submitted Adult Demographic record has at least one matching (same reporting period) Adult Course record. Please see the error codes listed below for an explanation of what type of validation error was found.

- *V4 A student may NOT be awarded a **Literacy Completion Point Code** of "F" and be tested using the Best Literacy test. Best Literacy does not have high enough scores to exit students out of Advanced ESOL. To earn a **Literacy Completion**, **Point Code** of "F", a student MUST be tested with Best Plus. Not required for Survey 11.
- *V5 For Surveys 11, 1, 2, and 3 each Adult Course record must have a matching Adult Demographic record based on CBO number,

 Student Number Identifier, Survey Period Code, and Reporting Year.
