

Element Name: Pre-Test Identification Number (Pre-Test ID)**Definition**

A unique ID created by the district assigned to the pre-test used to establish the beginning functioning level of the student in the course in a subject area. All students in National Reporting System (NRS) eligible courses must have a pre-test ID, with the exception of adult high school program.

See Adult Educational Functioning Level Subject Area for the content areas.

Note: Report code 9999 for students in a non-NRS program or students in an adult high school program. Also, report code 9999 if the student did not pre-test in multiple subject areas.
