Element Name: Student Number Identifier Definition

A ten-character code used to uniquely identify a student. The number must be maintained for all adult general education students.

If the student provides a social security number, the Student Number Identifier equals the social security number followed by an "X."

NNNNNNNX Example: 123456789X

If a student does not provide a social security number, The CBO should assign a number using the common statewide method.

First Three Digits

NNN For any student entering for the first time who does not have a social

security number, the first three digits will represent the CBO.

Last Seven Digits

NNNNNN The last seven digits are CBO-defined in such a way as to result in a unique

student number within the CBO where the number is originally

assigned.

Note:

Request a social security number for each Adult student who enrolls or who is enrolled in classes. However, a student is not required to provide his or her social security number as a condition for enrollment or graduation.
