EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

To comply with Senate Bill 7004 (2024), this rule establishes the criteria to identify a student with a substantial deficiency in early mathematics skills for any student in a Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program provided by a public school. In addition, the rule revises the criteria to identify a student with a substantial deficiency in mathematics for students in kindergarten through grade 4 and sets forth requirements for school districts to address these deficiencies.
