SUBJECT: Approval of Amendment to Rule 6A-1.099811, School Improvement State System of Support for Deficient and Failing Schools

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of the rule amendment is to incorporate legislative changes from House Bill 1285 (2024), Senate Bill 7002 (2024) and Senate Bill 7004 (2024), which amend sections (ss.) 1008.33 and 1012.2315, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and add requirements for a school district and charter school operator when a school district selects a charter turnaround option plan in the school improvement turnaround process. The rule changes define inexperienced teachers and a teacher in need of improvement, and clarify other requirements such as student enrollment, grade levels, rental or leasing fees, and administrative fees. Finally, amendments allow the State Board to give a community partnership school additional time to implement a community school model if the school is implementing a district-managed turnaround option plan and has been awarded a community school model grant.
