### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

A school district shall enter a Turnaround Option Plan with State Board approval, as set forth in Rule 6A-1.099811(7)(b), F.A.C.

This consent item is for the consideration of approval of District-Managed Turnaround Option Plans (TOP)-Step 2 for nine schools in five districts. These schools entered Tier 2 School Improvement status in their first cycle of turnaround because they either earned a single grade of F or two consecutive grades of D. The District-Managed TOP-Step 1 was approved by the State Board on October 15, 2024, with no additional conditions. The District-Managed TOP-Step 2 is a narrative describing how the district will implement the plan, including information about its systems to support school leadership teams, how it will ensure effective administrator capability of leading turnaround efforts, and how it will ensure effective educators are capable of improving student achievement.

The State Board of Education shall approve the District-Managed TOP-Step 2 for each of the following districts and schools to implement during the 2024-25 school year.
