EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

During the 2023 legislative session, Senate Bill 1190 created section 409.1455, Florida Statutes, requiring the State Board of Education to adopt a rule to award postsecondary credit or career education clock hours for eligible former foster youth participating in the workforce internship component of the Step into Success Pilot Program. The new rule establishes the responsibilities and rights of the institution and establishes the process the required documentation for the petition for the award of credit must adhere to. Students who are participating in DCF's Step into Success Pilot Program will have the opportunity to earn postsecondary credit or career education clock hours, therefore, advancing their academic careers, professional goals, and economic status.
