EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

North Florida College (NFC) submitted a notice of intent followed by a proposal to the Department of Education to offer a Bachelor of Applied Science in Organizational Management. Appropriate notification of intent was provided to the Board of Governors, Independent Colleges and Universities of Florida and the Commission for Independent Education, as required in section 1007.33, Florida Statutes.

The degree program will prepare graduates for high demand and high wage careers in businesses, government agencies, and non-profit organizations in positions including but not limited to financial managers, general and operations managers, human resource specialists and managers, social and community service managers, and business management analysts.

Labor market projections indicate a projected demand of 102 annual job openings in NFC's service district. There are no other institutions in NFC's service district.

Letters of support were provided by Career Source North Florida, Madison County Chamber of Commerce, Madison County Central School, and the North Florida College Foundation. There were no letters of objection or alternative proposals for the proposed degree program.

An extensive review of criteria was conducted for the proposal submitted, and written comments and recommendations were provided to the college. The final proposal is being submitted to the State Board of Education for consideration.
