

2024 PERFORMANCE-BASED EXIT OPTION MODEL APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Districts seeking approval to implement the Performance-Based Exit Option Model in the 2024-25 and 2025-26 school years, in accordance with Rule 6A-6.0212, Florida Administrative Code, must complete Parts A and B of the application available at

<https://www.flrules.org/gateway/readRefFile.asp?refId=16551&filename=2024%20PBEO%20Application%206A-6.0212.pdf>. Only Part A must be submitted electronically to the Department at BSI@fldoe.org by June 15, 2024.

Part A—District Application

The district application contains the programmatic assurances required by the American Council on Education, GED[®] Testing Service (GEDTS) and the Florida Department of Education. The district should provide comprehensive responses to the requests for information presented under each guideline. After each guideline, technical assistance with specific elements and the necessary information for approval is provided to simplify the completion of the application.

Part B—Site Evaluation Checklist

A site evaluation checklist must be completed by each implementing site within the district and submitted to the district office. The district office is responsible for maintaining the checklist.

When an application is approved, notification letters will be sent to the district superintendent and the individual designated as the district contact for the Performance-Based Exit Option Model. Upon approval, districts will implement the model and complete Part C for each participating student.

Part C—Student Evaluation Checklist

A Student Evaluation Checklist for each participating student must be completed by each implementing site within the district. The implementing site is responsible for maintaining each student's checklist.
