**SUBJECT**: 2020-21 Dr. Philip Benjamin Expenditure Report

Pursuant to section 1011.85(4)(b), Florida Statutes, each college must provide an annual expenditure report tracking the use of all appropriated matching funds under the Dr. Philip Benjamin Matching Grant Program. If your college has previously reported a "carry forward" balance in prior appropriated funds that have not yet been expended or endowed, you will need to use the attached expenditure form to report actual expenditures and endowments for fiscal year 2020-21, from all available appropriated matching funds, regardless of the fiscal year in which the funds were appropriated. The instructions for completing the form are attached.

- Please see the attached list of colleges that reported carry forward in fiscal years 2018-19 and 2019-20.
- There was no appropriation for the Philip Benjamin Matching Program in FY 2020-21; however, colleges with a carry forward of unexpended or encumbered funds from prior appropriations must complete this annual report detailing any subsequent expenditures or endowments since the last report.
- If your college **DID** report carry forward in 2019-20, **you will need** to complete an expenditure report for FY 2020-21.
- If your college DID NOT report carry forward in 2019-20, you will not need to complete a 2020-21 report UNLESS your college un-endowed any state matching funds (per college and foundation policy and applicable state law) and spent those in FY 2020-21.
