Since the release of the Get There campaign in September of 2020, we have seen success in promoting Career and Technical Education (CTE) offerings available at Florida's state colleges and technical centers/colleges. I want to thank you all for your continued support and effort in championing workforce education.

As a result of Florida's policies to support workforce education, the state currently has more than 772,000 K-12 CTE students—the highest in the state's history—more than 338,000 postsecondary CTE students, and over 15,000 registered apprentices engaged in workforce education.
