<sup>1</sup> On January 14, 2015, the State Board of Education established Achievement Levels for the Civics End-of-Course (EOC) Assessment. Winter 2014 U.S. Civics EOC Assessment scores were reported to students on the new score scale, but at that time, the Achievement Levels had not been established. The Winter 2014 results have been retrofitted to the established Achievement Levels so that stakeholders and the general public are able to see what the results would have been if the Achievement Levels had been approved and implemented at that time.
