

## Student Data Summary Form Data Element Crosswalk

Many of the items provided in this form are required data elements that must be reported during the regular survey windows. The following table addresses which items (self-selected by the student) on this Intake Form are directly related to required data elements showing those links and data element values. The information here is to assist in linking the information collected via this form to those data elements that are required to be reported using that state student-data reporting systems. Where appropriate, the accompanying equivalent data element/value is provided. In the case that more than one value is selected by the participant for a specified element, agencies should develop a local policy to determine which value is reported.

<sup>3</sup> If student does not indicate either “Single Parent” or “Single Pregnant Woman,” use Data Element Value of “Z” indicating the other data values do not apply to the student.

<sup>4</sup> If the student does not indicate “Ex-Offender,” use Data Element Value of “N” indicating the student does not self-identify as an “Ex-Offender.”

<sup>6</sup> The “AGE Homeless Individuals, Children, and Youths, or Runaway Youth” also includes “D-Runaway Youth.” Identifying runaway youth is left to local agency discretion using locally available program participation or locally defined procedures. If all other values for this data element (including D-Runaway Youth) do not apply, then use Data Element Value of “N” indicating the student does not self-identify as a homeless individual or runaway youth.

<sup>7</sup> If the student does not indicate “perceived employment barriers,” use Data Element Value of “N” indicating the student does not self-identify as having perceived barriers to employment.

<sup>9</sup> If the student does not select any of the values related to “AGE, Income Barriers” or the FCS “AGE Income Status” data elements, use Data Element Value of “N” indicating the student does not self-identify as meeting the criteria of these data elements.

<sup>10</sup> For “AGE, Income Barriers” in both the WDIS and CBO databases, codes “A,” “B,” and “C” are not mutually exclusive, but the data element allows for up to three characters to be reported. If the student self-identifies more than one option, report all codes selected by the student.
