Attachment 3: Business Rules for the District Industry Certification Allocation for 2014-15

Three categories of industry certifications are included in the calculation:

- Eligible Category 1: Certifications reported on the final 2013-14 WDIS submission that were eligible for funding but not included in the 2013-14 funding allocation
- Eligible Category 2: Certifications reported on the 2014-15 WDIS Survey F and W matched to students enrolled in 2013-14 in the same program in which the certification was reported
- Eligible Category 3: Certifications reported on the final 2014-15 WDIS system matched to students enrolled in 2014-15 in the same program in which the certification was reported
