RAISE High School Tutoring Program: New Worlds Scholars

Per Section 1003.485(8)(c), F.S., and Rule 6A-6.0531(4)(d), F.A.C., RAISE tutors who provide at least 75 hours of tutoring under the program will be recognized as New Worlds Scholars and receive a New Worlds Scholar certificate and a pin. Participating school districts must verify completion of 75 tutoring hours for students.

Districts and the Department will follow the process outlined below to verify the number of students who have met 75 hours of tutoring in RAISE schools and to provide certificates and pins.

New Worlds Scholar Recognition Process:

There are three reporting dates per year: **September 15, January 15, and April 15.**

- **Step 1**: Participating district identifies students who have provided at least 75 hours of tutoring in RAISE schools.
- **Step 2**: District reports to Just Read, Florida! the number (not names) of students who have provided at least 75 hours of tutoring in RAISE schools via the <u>New Worlds Scholar Verification Form.</u>
- **Step 3**: The district will receive an electronic, fillable New Worlds Scholar certificate with the Commissioner's electronic signature and New Worlds Scholar pins for the number of identified students during the reporting period.
