THE DEVELOPMENTAL RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN PHONOLOGICAL SKILLS AND WORD-LEVEL READING

Phonological Skill Development

EARLY PHONOLOGICAL AWARENESS

Rhyming, first sounds, syllable segmentation



BASIC PHONEMIC AWARENESS

Blending and segmenting



PHONEMIC PROFICIENCY/ADVANCED PHONEMIC AWARENESS

Automatic, unconscious access to phonemes in spoken words

Word Reading Skill Development

LETTER NAMES AND LETTER SOUNDS

Phonological storage and retrieval



PHONIC DECODING AND ENCODING (spelling)



ORTHOGRAPHIC MAPPING

Efficient memory for printed words; rapid sight vocabulary expansion
