## **Scholarship Program**

## FEBRUARY REPORT 2006

The Corporate Tax Credit Scholarship Program was established to encourage private, voluntary contributions from corporate donors to non-profit scholarship funding organizations that award scholarships to children from low-income families. A corporation can receive a dollar for dollar tax credit up to 75% of its state income tax liability, and the state may award a maximum of \$88 million in credits each year. This program expands educational opportunities and school choice for children of families that have limited financial resources.

This report is based on student participation statistics through February of the 2005-2006 school year.





### **CTC Students Enrollment by Gender**






#### **CTC Students Racial/Ethnic Enrollment**



# CTC Students Enrollment by Scholarship Funding Organization (SFO)


