## FEBRUARY QUARTERLY REPORT 2009


#### Abstract

The Corporate Tax Credit (CTC) Scholarship Program was established to encourage private, voluntary contributions from corporate donors to non-profit scholarship funding organizations that award scholarships to children from low-income families. A corporation can receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit up to $75 \%$ of its state income tax liability, and the state may award a maximum of $\$ 118$ million in credits for the 2008-09 fiscal year. This program expands educational opportunities and school choice for children of families that have limited financial resources.
