## NOVEMBER QUARTERLY REPORT <br> 2006


#### Abstract

The Corporate Tax Credit (CTC) Scholarship Program was established to encourage private, voluntary contributions from corporate donors to non-profit scholarship funding organizations that award scholarships to children from low-income families. A corporation can receive a dollar for dollar tax credit up to $75 \%$ of its state income tax liability, and the state may award a maximum of $\$ 88$ million in credits each year. This program expands educational opportunities and school choice for children of families that have limited financial resources.
