FEBRUARY QUARTERLY REPORT 2012

Florida Tax Credit (FTC) The Scholarship Program was established in 2001 to encourage private, voluntary contributions corporate to non-profit scholarship from donors funding organizations (SFO) that award scholarships to children from low-income families. Step Up For Students is the only approved participating SFO for the 2011-12 school year. A corporation can receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit up to 100% of its state income tax liability. The program also includes credits against the insurance premium tax for contributions to eligible non-profit SFOs, credits against severance taxes on oil and gas production, self-accrued sales tax liabilities of direct pay permit holders, and alcoholic beverage taxes on beer, wine, and spirits. The maximum amount the state may award is \$175 million in credits for the 2011-2012 This program expands educational opportunities and fiscal year. school choice for children of families that have limited financial resources.







FTC Student Enrollment by Grade Level


Private Schools Participating in FTC by Type
