## FLORIDA TAX CREDIT <br> Scholarship Program

## SEPTEMBER QUARTERLY REPORT 2009


#### Abstract

The Corporate Tax Credit (CTC) Scholarship Program was established to encourage private, voluntary contributions from corporate donors to non-profit scholarship funding organizations that award scholarships to children from low-income families. A corporation can receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit up to $75 \%$ of its state income tax liability. In 2009, the program changed its name to the Florida Tax Credit (FTC) Scholarship Program and expanded to provide credits against the insurance premium tax for contributions to eligible non-profit scholarship funding organizations. The maximum amount the state may award is $\$ 118$ million in credits for the 2009-2010 fiscal year. This program expands educational opportunities and school choice for children of families that have limited financial resources.
