## PRIOR SCHOOL STATUS/STUDENT ATTENDANCE - REJECT RULES

17. Withdrawal Code, PK-12 must be DNE, W01, W02, W3A, W3B, W04, W05, W06, W07, W08, W8A, W8B, W09, W10, W12, W13, W15, W18, W21, W22, W23, W24, W25, W26, W27, WFT, WFW, WRW, WGA, WGD, WXL, WXT, WXW, WD1 or WPO. It may also be ZZZ only for survey periods 2 and 3. -record rejected-

**Note:** See DOE Information Database Requirements: Volume I -- Automated Student Information System Manual, Appendix A for acceptable withdrawal codes for grades PK-12 students.

### EXAMPLE


The first record listed below would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because the Withdrawal Code, PK-12 is not valid. The third record would be rejected because a Withdrawal Code, PK-12 of ZZZ is not valid for the Survey Period Code.

 35. If Withdrawal Code, PK-12 is W06, W07, W08, W8A, W8B, W09, W10, W27, WFT, WFW, WRW, WGA, WGD, WXL, WXT, WXW, WD1 or WPO or then Grade Level must be 9-12. –record rejected-

### EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because Grade Level is not equal to 9-12 and Withdrawal Code, PK-12 is W8A.

A one-character code used to indicate the basis of exit out of the English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) program. Codes B, C, D, E and F are composed of two or more measures.

Code	Definition/Example
A	Aural/Oral - only for use with K-2 students exited from an ESOL program prior to July 1, 2009.
B	CELLA Composite Score and CELLA Reading Score – Scores equal to or greater than the CELLA composite scores shall be used to determine the level of English proficiency for students tested in listening, speaking, reading and writing (see table below). The CELLA Reading score must be on grade level. The second measure must be an academic Reading assessment on grade level. Valid prior to the 2012 CELLA administration.
C	A score at or above the proficient level on a State approved listening and speaking assessment or above the publisher’s cut score on an aural and oral assessment. If this measure is used for students in grades 3-12, the second measure shall be an assessment in reading and writing. Valid prior to the 2012 CELLA administration.
D	A score at or above the 33rd national percentile on the reading comprehension and writing or language usage subtests on a nationally norm referenced test. The second measure shall be a listening and speaking or aural and oral assessment. Valid prior to the 2012 CELLA administration.
E	FCAT level 3 or greater or the equivalent developmental scale score on the Reading test of the Sunshine State Standards. The second measure shall be an assessment in listening and speaking or aural and oral, and writing. Valid prior to the 2012 CELLA administration.
F	FCAT level 3 or greater on the Writing+ of the Sunshine State Standards. The second measure shall be an assessment in listening and speaking or aural and oral, and reading---for use only with students exited from an ESOL program prior to July 1, 2008. Valid prior to the 2012 CELLA administration.
G	District-proposed alternative exit standard as amended into the District's ELL Plan and approved by the Department of Education---for use only with students exited from an ESOL program prior to July 1, 2008.
H	For grades K-2, qualifying exit scores on the English Language Assessments per Rule 6A-6.0903.
I	For grades 3-10, qualifying exit scores on the English Language Assessments per Rule 6A-6.0903, including an achievement level of 3 or higher on FCAT Reading or FSA in English Language Arts (ELA).
J	For grades 10-12, qualifying exit scores on the English Language Assessments per Rule 6A-6.0903 and a score on the 10th Grade FCAT Reading or FSA in English Language Arts (ELA) sufficient to meet applicable graduation requirements or an equivalent concordant score pursuant to Section 1008.22, F.S.
L	English Language Learners (ELL) Committee
R	Reading and Writing---for use only with students exited from an ESOL program prior to July 1, 2008.
