ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS INFORMATION – REJECT RULES

22. If English Language Learners: Entry Date is ~~September 1, 2005 or greater~~ a valid date, then Test Name Listening must be a valid test on the Test Name Table in Appendix I with an indicator code of L (Listening) or Test Name Listening may be ZZZ. ~~If English Language Learners: Entry Date is prior to September 1, 2005 Test Name Listening must be a valid test on the Test Name Table in Appendix I, other than X__, or Test Name Listening may be ZZZ.~~ If District Number, Current Enrollment is 68, then Test Name Listening may be X__. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because the Test Name is invalid. ~~The third record would be rejected because the ELL Entry Date is after September 1, 2005 and the Test Name is valid only before that date.~~

If English Language Learners: Entry Date is **September 1, 2005 or greater** a **valid date, then** Test Name Writing must be an approved test listed on the Test Name Table in Appendix I with an indicator code of W (Writing) or Test Name Writing may be ZZZ. ~~If English Language Learners: Entry Date is prior to September 1, 2005, Test Name Writing must be on the Test Name Table in Appendix I, other than X__, or Test Name Writing may be ZZZ.~~ If District Number is 68, then Test Name Writing may be X__. ~~If District Number, Current Enrollment is 50 and Test Date: Writing is between 07/01/2006 and 06/30/2008, then Test Name: Writing may be X__.~~ ~~If District Number, Current Enrollment is 55 and Test Date is prior to September 1, 2010, then Test Name Writing may be X__.~~ -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because the Test Name is invalid. ~~The third record would be rejected because ELL Entry Date is later than September 1, 2005 and the Test Name is valid only before that date.~~

NEW EDIT FOR 2021

65. If Location of Student equals I, then Blended Learning Course must equal N on the matching Teacher Course record.

The Student Course record must have a matching Teacher Course record based on the key fields of District Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Number, Current Instruction/ Service; Survey Period Code; Fiscal Year; Course Number; Section Number; Period Number; and Term. -state validation/NULL-

****FTE Reported, Course set to NULL following the close of the State Records Processing Cycle.****

EXAMPLE

The first Student Course record listed below would pass this edit. The second Student Course record would be flagged in error because the matching Teacher Course record has a “Y” code for Blended Learning Course.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If data for Location of Student on the Student Course record is valid, then the district must set the code for Blended Learning on the Matching Teacher Course record to N. If the Student Course record is invalid, delete the record from the database. If an error has been made in one or more of the data elements required to match on either the Student Course record or the Teacher Course record, then the record(s) should be

corrected so that the two types of records match for each of the data elements of District Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Number, Current Instruction/Service; Survey Period Code; Fiscal Year; Course Number; Section Number; Period Number; and Term.
