SUBJECT: **Re-Advertisement 2021-2022 Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) of 2014, Title II - Adult Education and Family Literacy Act (AEFLA) Grants Posted on the Web and Funding Opportunities Webinar Scheduled to Review Submission Requirements**

The Re-Advertisement of Adult Education Requests for Proposal (RFP) is now posted on the Division's website at www.fldoe.org/WIOAGrants. These federal funds are authorized under the Adult Education and Family Literacy Act of 2014.

The funds are available for select counties to eligible applicants to assist adults in becoming literate, obtaining knowledge and skills necessary for employment and self-sufficiency, obtaining the education skills necessary to become full partners in their children's education, and completing their secondary school education. Applications are due on or before **Monday, November 1, 2021**, for the following counties:

- Adult General Education and Family Literacy serving the following counties: Dixie, Franklin, Glades, Gulf, Hamilton, Holmes, Jefferson, Lafayette, Madison.
- English Literacy/Civics Education serving the following counties: Bay, Gadsden, Glades, Hernando, Jackson, Pasco, Putnam, Santa Rosa, Sumter.
