Prekindergarten Child Outcome Summary (COS)

Prekindergarten COS Train-the-Trainer sessions will be offered by TATS via a two-day Zoom training series. District administrators can select from two options for participating staff, both options are from 9:00 to 11:30 a.m. EST, on **May 19 and 21** or **June 8 and 9, 2021**. It is recommended for district administrators to include those individuals identified as being a part of the initial COS process or those who provide prekindergarten professional development as they will be the ones conducting entry starting **July 1, 2021**, and will play a role in training the rest of district personnel at a later date. All trainings will be done by TATS to support the transition to the COS, which will begin on **July 1, 2021**. The offered training is required by all districts in support of Preschool Child Outcomes - Federal Part B Indicator 7. 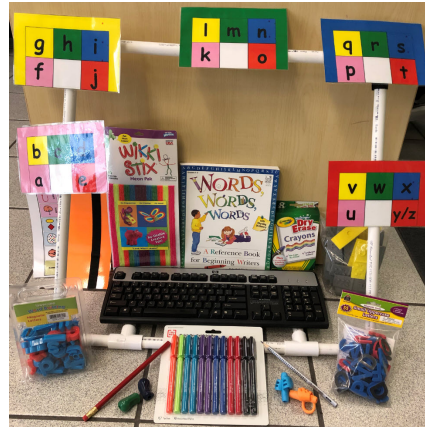
