# 1. District Number, Current Enrollment must be numeric and in the range 01-70 or 72-76. -record rejected-

#### EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected since the District Number, Current Enrollment is not within the appropriate range.

The first of these would be rejected because the School Number, Current Enrollment is not in the appropriate numerical range. The second of these two records would be rejected because the School Number, Current Enrollment is not numeric.

3. The first nine positions of Student Number Identifier, Florida must be numeric. The tenth position of Student Number Identifier, Florida must either be an "X" or numeric. If the tenth position of Student Number Identifier, Florida is numeric, the first two digits must be a valid district number in the range 01-70 or 72-76. -record rejected-

Note: For more information on Student Number Identifier, Florida refer to <u>DOE</u> <u>Information Data Base Requirements: Volume I -- Automated Student Information</u> <u>System</u> Manual.

# EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because when the social security number is used as the Student Number Identifier, Florida, the tenth position must be an "X". The fourth and sixth records would be rejected because the Student Number Identifier, Florida contains blanks. The fifth record would be rejected because the first two digits are not a valid district number.

# 4. Survey Period Code must be F, W, or S and must be correct for the submission specified by the district. -record rejected-

#### EXAMPLE

If the Survey Period Code as specified in the transmission JCL or in the statements for tape transmission was identified as Survey Period Code "W" and records were coded with Survey Period Code "F", all updates, adds, or deletes with this inconsistency would be rejected.

#### DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The District must correct the Survey Period Code either on the transmission JCL or on the records and resubmit the records.

# 5. Fiscal Year must be correct for the submission specified by the district. -record rejected-

# EXAMPLE

The Fiscal Year as specified in the transmission JCL or in statements for tape transmission is identified as "9899". However, records on the transmission have Fiscal Year coded as "9798". All updates, adds or deletes with this inconsistency would be rejected.

# DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

Correct the Fiscal Year either on the records coming in or the transmission JCL and resubmit all records.

# 6. District Number, Current Instruction/Services must be numeric in the range 01-70 or 72-76 and must be correct for the district submitting the data. -record rejected-

#### EXAMPLE

If district 01 is submitting records, District Number, Current Instruction/Services must be 01 for all records. In the records listed below, the first two records would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected since the District Number, Current Instruction/Services is 02 rather than 01 (the number of the district submitting the record).

The first and second records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Vocational/Adult General Education (AGE) Program Code is not a valid postsecondary vocational program number.

The third record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The first and second records would be rejected because the Course Number contains blanks or is not a valid Course Number.

Records with an incorrect Transaction Code would be rejected.

# DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Transaction Code and resubmit the records.

21. Each record must be unique based on Student Number Identifier, Florida; Survey Period Code; Fiscal Year; District Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Number, Current Instruction/Service; Course Number; Section Number; Period Number and Term. -First record accepted, all other duplicate records rejected-

#### EXAMPLE

The fifth and eighth records listed below would be rejected because the key items (Student Number Identifier, Florida; Survey Period Code; Fiscal Year; District Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Number, Current Instruction/Service; Course Number; Section Number; Period Number and Term) duplicate the key items in a previous record. The first of two records with the same key information will be loaded to the data base file, assuming it meets all other applicable criteria. Any subsequent records submitted with duplicate data in all the key items would be rejected.

# DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The district should verify whether or not the record generating the message should have been submitted, or if there should be a matching record. If the record should not have been submitted, it should be deleted. If there should be a matching record based on the criteria in the edit, that record should be submitted. If the data are accurate as submitted, no action is necessary.

#### DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The district should verify the student's Vocational/Adult General Education Termination Code and Vocational/Adult General Education Completion Point Code to assure that the data are accurate. If either data element is incorrect, make the appropriate correction and resubmit the record. If the reported data elements are correct, no action is neccessary.
