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<b>Element Name:</b> <b>Adult General Education Functioning Level, Final</b>																	
<b>Definition/Domain</b>																	
<p>A federally-defined code indicating the Adult General Education or English Language functioning level of the adult general education student for the class at the end of the reporting period.</p> <p>A student may be assigned only one final adult educational functioning level on each reporting record. Based upon the instruction being reported on the record, select the most appropriate response from those listed under either Adult General Education (Adult Basic Education and Adult Secondary Education), Adult ESOL, or Adult VESOL.</p> <p>For the <u>final <b>Adult General Education</b> functioning level</u>, use the following codes to relate functioning levels to grade levels. <u>CODE</u>	<u>DEFINITION</u>
<b>2</b>	Literacy/Foundation, SPL 0-2
<b>3</b>	Low Beginning, SPL 3
<b>4</b>	High Beginning SPL 4
<b>5</b>	Low Intermediate SPL 5
<b>6</b>	High Intermediate, SPL 6
<b>7</b>	Advance, SPL 7

For the final **Adult VESOL** functioning level, use the following codes to relate functioning level to student Performance Levels (SPLs).

<u>CODE</u>	<u>DEFINITION</u>
<b>C</b>	Beginning, SPL 2-3
<b>D</b>	Intermediate, SPL 4-5
<b>E</b>	Advanced, SPL 6-7
