## DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

Correct the WDIS Reporting Year codes either on the JCL or the records being submitted and resubmit the records.

Course Number must not contain blanks and must be a valid postsecondary course number on the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Edit file (F61730) or a valid number on the Course Code Directory file in the range 0100300-2499990, 7910010-7980990, 8002000-9001920 and 9900010. -record rejected-
