Some financial aid disbursements for the same award year were made during the summer term but fell after the June 30 fiscal year cutoff, resulting in a timing variance in reported expenditures that shows an underexpenditure of need-based aid. The transition to the new financial aid management system and the resulting delays in posting and disbursing of the awards further contributed to the timing variance in reported expenditures.
