

LOCAL PLACEMENT METHOD DATA COLLECTION Form No. ALTPLACE-02

Section (s.) 1008.30, Florida Statutes (F.S.) requires the State Board of Education to develop and implement a common placement test for the purpose of assessing the readiness of degree-seeking students for college-level work in communication and computation.

Additionally, Florida College System (FCS) institutions may use one or more approved alternative methods identified in Rule 6A-10.0315, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), in lieu of or in addition to a common placement test. Institutions that wish to use a local placement method as a measure of college readiness must seek approval through the established application and approval process.

Rule 6A-10.0315, F.A.C., requires FCS institutions that have been approved to use a local placement method to participate in an annual data collection process to monitor the usage of local placement methods and student performance in coursework.

To fulfill this requirement, colleges must complete Form No. ALTPLACE-02 once per year by July 1. The completed Local Placement Method Data Collection form must be submitted to the Division of Florida Colleges at <u>FCSInfo@fldoe.org</u>.
