**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Section 1007.01(3)(c), F.S., directs the Articulation Coordinating Committee (ACC) to annually recommend dual enrollment courses and high school subject equivalencies for approval by the State Board of Education and the Board of Governors. The recommended changes were approved by the ACC on January 30, 2026.

Section 1007.271(9), F.S., separately requires the Commissioner of Education to recommend to the State Board of Education those postsecondary courses identified to meet high school graduation requirements, by their course numbers and based on mastery of course outcomes.

The purpose of the Dual Enrollment Course-High School Subject Area Equivalency List is to establish the equivalencies required by both statutes. All high schools must accept these postsecondary education courses, as indicated in the list, toward meeting the high school graduation requirements of s. 1003.4282, F.S.

Included in the 2026-27 equivalency list are course equivalencies that align with general education course requirements at Florida's public state colleges and universities. Only two new courses were added to this year's list.
